Fermented with native yeasts and aged sur lie for 2 months. Inviting aromas of slate/mineral, baking spices, acacia, and melon lead to an intense, concentrated, nicely proportioned white with very good volume and length.

2015 Domaine Salvard "Unique" Sauvignon Blanc

Loire Valley, France

Fragrant Sauvignon Blanc from a little known appellation northeast of the Loire. The nose displays a characteristic Loire grassiness backed by flint and minerality. The palate is crisp & zingy with notes of tangy apples leading to a soft, rounded finish.

Loire Valley, France

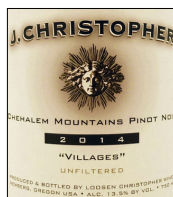


2015 Les Rocailles, Apremont

2014 J.Christopher, Chehalem Mtns. "Villages" Pinot Noir

Chehalem Mountains, Oregon

Aromatic & finely detailed with a lovely combination of violet, plum, jasmine, and lavender that build as it unfolds in the glass. Silk-laden, very mouth-crawling, sultry pinot palate. Tightens as expected on the finish revealing lots of length and immense potential.

2015 Isle Saint Pierre, Red Wine

France

Delightfully aromatic with sweet dark fruit—berry, damson plum, black currant jam, and dark milk chocolate. The palate is drier than the nose suggests, structured by its acidity rather than its fine tannins. The black fruits are there, joined by red fruit and a touch of pepper at the mid-palate, and a certain chocolatey sweetness on the finish.

"Le More" refers to the blackberry character of this deep and lively Sangiovese di Romagna. The grapes are harvested from the end of September to mid-October, then fermented and aged in stainless steel in order to retain the fresh & fruity character of the wine.

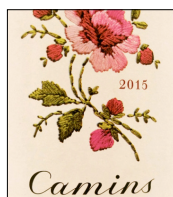


2015 Viña Zorzal, Garnacha
