

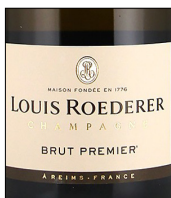


Veuve Clicquot, Brut with ice jacket

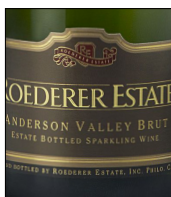


Louis Roederer, Brut Premier

Reims, France

The new release of Brut Premier is from the base year of 2012 and was disgorged in the spring of 2016, after spending three years aging on its fine lees. The blend consists of 40% Chardonnay, 40% Pinot Noir, and 20% Pinot Meunier. The bouquet is a blend of apple, white peach, gentle leesiness, pâtissière, lovely soil tones, and a smoky topnote.

Anderson Valley, California

Founded in 1981, Roederer Estate is nestled in Mendocino County's fog-shrouded, Anderson Valley. As the California property of Champagne Louis Roederer, Roederer Estate builds upon a centuries-old tradition of fine winemaking. This wine is lightly fruity and elegant, with complex pear, spice, and hazelnut flavors.

2014 Argyle, Vintage Brut

Willamette Valley, Oregon

The 2014 sparkling wine vintage in the Willamette Valley was pristine. The Pinot Noir dominated blend provides impressive red-fruited dimension to the ripe pear, fig and roasted hazelnut. The middle palate is invigorated with dynamic acid backbone and edgy minerality, bringing balance and concentration to the long finish.

Reims, France

James Suckling, 93 points! "A very appealing and satisfying style that fully captures the elegance and poise of Chardonnay. The aromas here are all based around lemons, grapefruit, honey, fresh floral notes, stone fruits, and toasty autolysis, which is somewhat of a signature for this Champagne. The palate delivers a ripe, flavorful impression of peach custard and lemon crème brûlée."

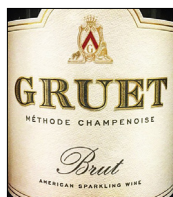
Chandon, Brut or Rosé- XO Rebecca Minkoff Package

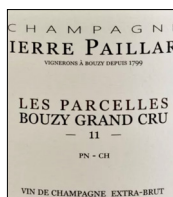


Krug, 164th Edition Grande Cuvée

Reims, France

This wine is absolutely brilliant & one of the best iterations of this iconic wine. This is not surprising, as it's from the base year of 2008, though the team at Krug utilized reserve wines all the way back to 1990 in this version. The final cépages is 48% Pinot Noir, 35% Chardonnay and 17% Pinot Meunier, with the wine spending eight years in the Krug cellars. A beautiful bouquet of apple, white peach, fresh-baked bread, white flowers, incipient smokiness.

Pierre Paillard "Les Parcelles X11" Grand Cru Extra Brut

Bouzy, France

Wine Spectator, 92 points! Pierre Paillard is a grower house started in 1768 with a heritage going back eight generations. The NV Grand Cru is crafted from 100% estate-grown fruit from wine that's aged an average of 25 years. This bubbly has a depth and creamy richness that highlights notes of brioche, caramelized pears and honey, with a finish that is all wood smoke, salt and lingering toastiness.

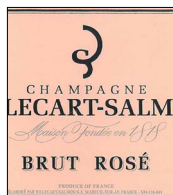


Pierre Péters "Cuvée de Réserve" Blanc de Blancs

Le Mesnil-sur-Oger, France

Wine Spectator, 93 points! For six generations and nearly 100 years, the Pierre Péters estate has been producing Grand Cru Blanc in the small village of Mesnil. Vibrating with an elegant electricity, its vigorous effervescence creates a charged and dynamic mouthfeel, bringing with it flavors of baked pear, apple blossom, lime, and honeydew.
